NEW EUROPEAN SYSTEMS: EES AND ETIAS



Two new border management initiatives that will affect travel to Europe Both systems aim to facilitate legitimate travel to the EU in a secure and safe way



Registers non-EU travellers entering the 29 Schengen countries for a short stay

- Started on 12 October 2025
- Replaces physical stamping of passport
- Travellers' biometrics registered and verified




New travel authorisation for visa-free travellers to enter the 29 Schengen countries and Cyprus for a short stay

- Starts in the last quarter of 2026
- **EUR 20 fee** (age: 18-70)
- Valid for 3 years or until the passport expires

ETIAS: NEW EUROPEAN TRAVEL REQUIREMENT



ETIAS: THE NEW EUROPEAN TRAVEL AUTHORISATION

For visa-free travellers to enter **30 European countries** for a **short stay**

- Starts in the last quarter of 2026
- Apply online at europa.eu/etias
- Valid for up to 3 years for multiple entries
- For short stays of up to 90 days in any 180-day period
- Similar travel authorisations in the US, Canada, Australia and the UK







ETIAS IS NEEDED TO TRAVEL TO 30 EUROPEAN COUNTRIES







WHAT CHANGES FOR TRAVELLERS

- Must obtain their travel authorisation before starting the trip
 - If ETIAS refused, no possibility to apply for a visa
- Must travel with the same passport as the one used in the ETIAS application
- Carriers and border authorities check that travellers have a valid ETIAS
 - No ETIAS = no entry
- Must have a valid ETIAS during the entire stay in Europe

In most cases ETIAS will be granted within minutes.

WHAT THE EES AND ETIAS MEAN FOR CARRIERS

- Applies to international airlines, cruise/ferry lines and bus companies
- These carriers will have to verify that their non-EU passengers have a valid ETIAS travel authorisation or a short-term visa
- The verification of travellers must be done within 48 hours before departure
- Carriers need to register with the EU to be able to verify their passengers



HOW TRAVEL AGENTS MIGHT BE AFFECTED

1

Travel agencies that **own means of transport and use it to transport non-EU nationals** into countries that use EES and require
ETIAS must register as a carrier to verify points (a) and (c) below.



Without prior registration, travel agents and tour operators **will not be able** to manually check:

- a) consumption of entries of single/double entry visas
- b) available remaining days authorised by those visas
- c) possession and validity of ETIAS travel authorisations



1. General Questions

1.1 What is the Entry and Exit System (EES)?

The Entry and Exit System (EES) is an automated IT system that electronically registers each entry into or exit from the territory of European countries that use the system by travellers who are in the scope of EES (Please see Q/A Which travellers are in the scope of EES), recording the time and place of their entry/sixt and calculating the duration of their authorised stay, it also registers refusals of entry and penerates alerts for overstayers. When the system enters into operation, it will replace the manual stamping of travel documents by border authorities.

.2 What is the European Travel Information and Authorisation System (ETIAS)?

The European Travel Information and Authorisation System (ETIAS) is a system for granting authorisation for vise-exempt third-country nationals to travel to European countries for a short-term stay. The information travellers provide in their application form when requesting an ETIAS travel authorisation will support European countries in determining whether they pose a security. Illegal immigration or epidemic risk.

.3 What legislation regulates the implementation of EES, ETIAS and carrier related obligations?

The instruments are, in their current and consolidated version:

For EES

Regulation (EU) 2017/2226 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 30 November 2017 establishing an Entry/Exit System (EES) to register entry and exit data and refusal of entry data of third-country nationals crossing the external borders of the Member States and determining the conditions for access to the EES for law enforcement purposes, and amending the <u>Convention implementina</u> the <u>Schengen Agreement</u> (CISA) and Regulations (EC) No 767/2008 and (EU) No 1077/2011. Bereinafter referred to as Regulation (EU) 2017/2226.

BEWARE OF UNOFFICIAL ETIAS WEBSITES

- Applying for an ETIAS travel authorisation for someone else is legal
- ... but caution is needed as some intermediaries may be involved in unethical business practices
- Over 150 fake and unofficial ETIAS websites already operating
- Risks posed by dubious intermediaries include fraud, identity theft, cybersecurity issues, misinformation and high processing fees
